#### **Mission Without Borders**

#### **Gravesham Foodbank**

Dependency on foodbanks is soaring. Recent figures released this month by the Trussell Trust reveal that a record 1.5 million emergency food parcels were provided between April and September 2023. This includes food parcels distributed to over 265,000 children living in UK families.

Thank you to all who continuously contribute to the foodbank. As Ron, Mike and Nikki all work at our local Gravesham foodbank they are very willing to deliver our contributions.
